Compilation and dissemination of Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS) is one of the core activities of Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS). Considering the importance of FTS, BBS has been compiling and publishing it on an annual basis since 1973-74. Since February 2007, BBS has been publishing **Monthly Advance Release** on FTS to satisfy the users' need. It is an outcome of the BBS efforts towards the improvement of FTS.

This monthly release is based on the data available from National Board of Revenue (NBR) and Bangladesh Bank (BB). NBR provides export and import data on goods while BB provides such data on services. We are thankful to NBR and BB which have continued to help us in providing data in bringing out this publication.

Data presented in this publication are provisional and subject to revision. All these provisional data will be subsequently reviewed and revised. The revised data will be presented in the upcoming issues.

I firmly believe this publication will play a significant role as an effective market research tool to planners, policy makers, researchers, the business community and others. Comments and suggestions from users regarding any inclusion, omission or presentation of data for improvement of the publication are most welcome.

I would like to express my heartfelt thanks to Mr. Md. Dilder Hossain, Deputy Director and Syed Md. Yusuf Hossain, Assistant Statistical Officer, BBS and all other officers and staffs of Foreign Trade Section for their relentless effort to make the publication possible.

Total Trade (Goods & Services)

In October, 2009 total exports and imports of goods and services were recorded at Tk.95.54 billion and Tk. 192.82 billion respectively resulting in a trade deficit of goods and services of Tk.97.28 billion. The exports in October, 2009 were Tk9.39 billion higher than that in September, 2009 and the imports in October, 2009 were Tk.57.54 billion higher than that in September, 2009.

Goods

In October, 2009, the trade deficit for goods appeared to Tk.88.41 billion as against Tk.40.12 billion in September, 2009. The exports of goods in October, 2009 have increased by 5.86% over against that in September, 2009 and the imports of goods in October, 2009 have increased by 45.35% as compared to that in September, 2009. The export of goods in October, 2009 is Tk80.62 billion as against Tk.59.72 billion in October, 2008. The import of goods in October, 2009 is Tk.169.03 billion as against Tk.150.82 billion in October, 2008.

Services

In October, 2009, the trade deficit for services decreases to Tk8.87 billion as against Tk 9.01 billion in September, 2009. The exports of services in October, 2009 have increased by 49.50% over against September, 2009 and the imports of services in October, 2009 have increased by 25.28% as compared with that in September, 2009. The export of services in October, 2009 is Tk.14.92 billion which was Tk.8.51 billion in October, 2008. The import of services in October, 2009 is Tk23.79 billion as against Tk.24.51 billion in October, 2008.

Three months moving Average of exports and imports

For the three months ending in September, 2009, the moving average of exports of goods and services was Tk.96.72 billion, while the moving average of imports of goods and services was Tk.155.31 billion resulting in an average trade deficit of Tk.58.59 billion. For the three months ending in August, 2009, the average trade deficit was Tk.24.31 billion, reflecting average exports of Tk101.20 billion and average imports of Tk 125.51 billion.

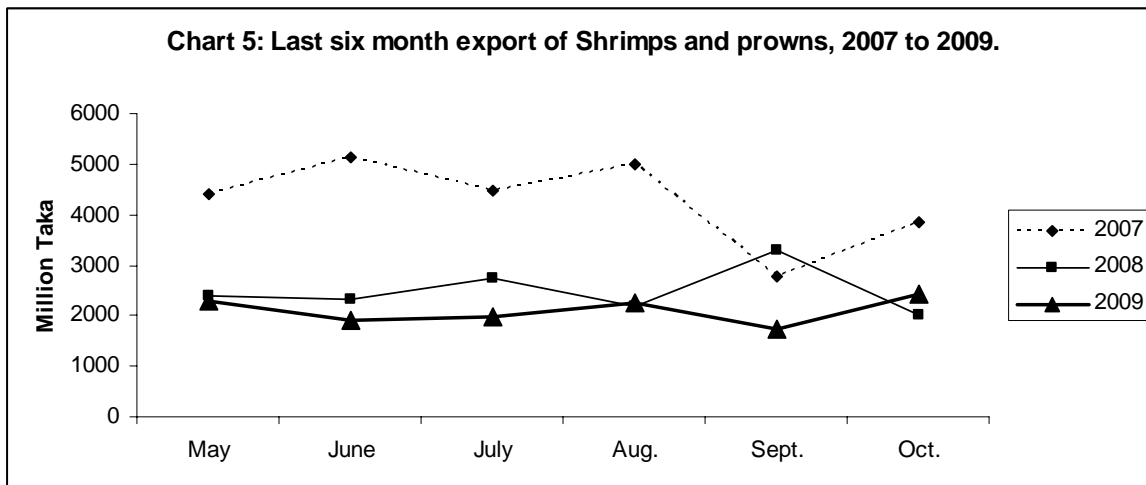

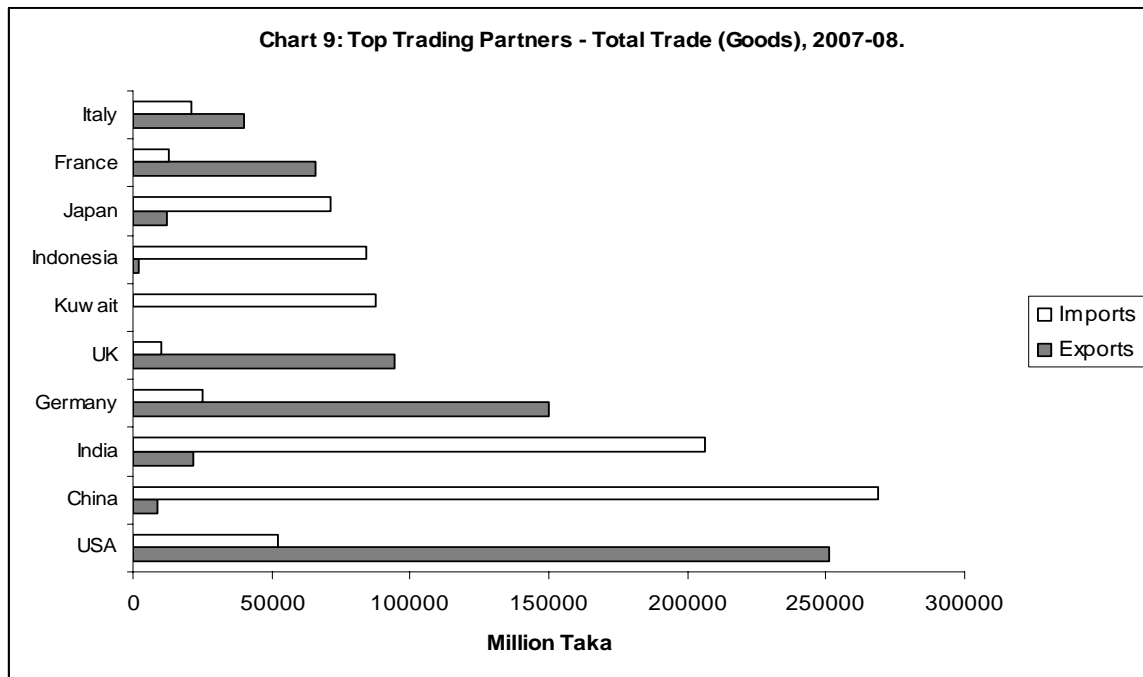
