Chart 1: Average Daily Wage Rate Index

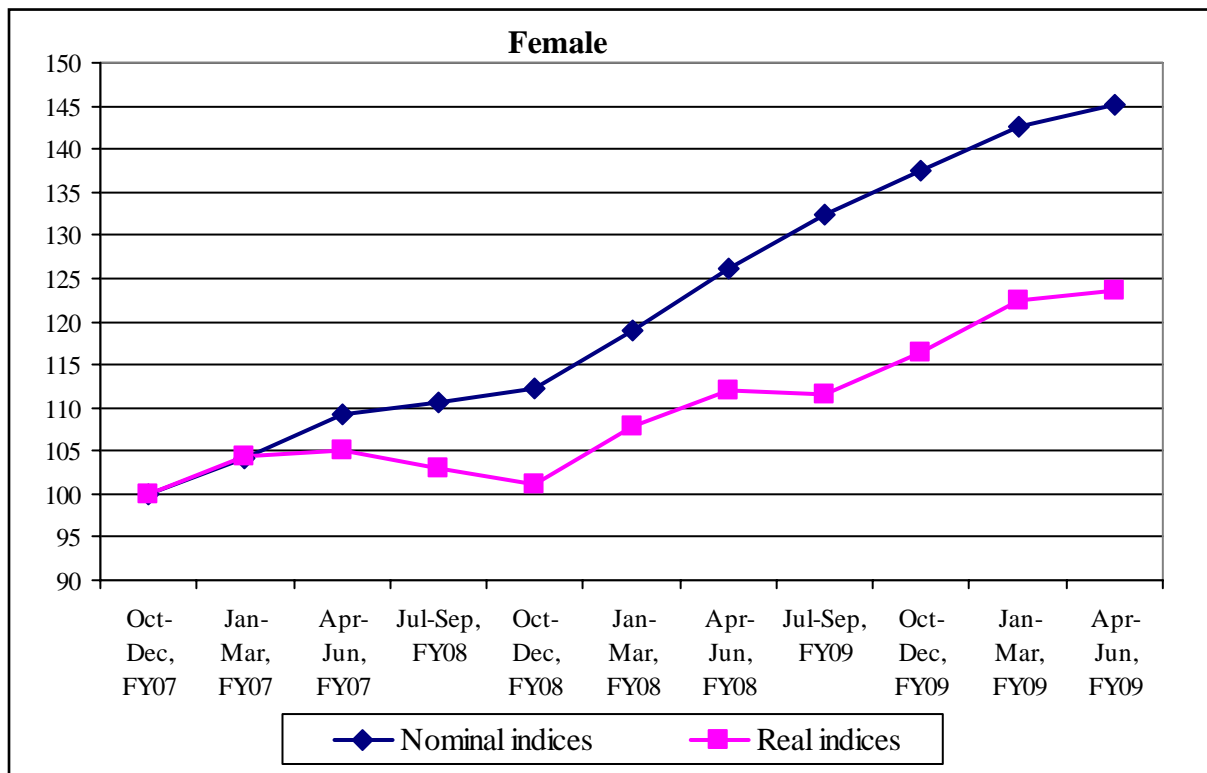
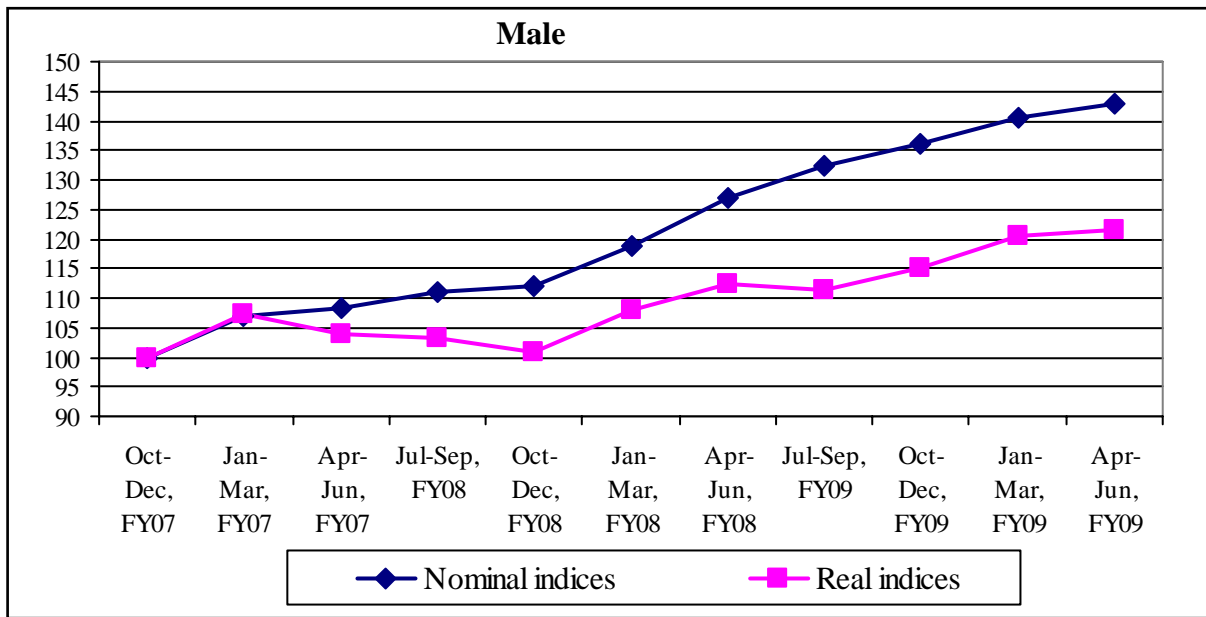
